Grammar Reference

WH-question with “where”

“where” is used to ask about a place.

Example:

Where do you live? I live in Phnom Penh.

Where do you come from? I come from the U.S.

Preposition “from”

“be from” and “come from” are used to show someone’s native country or someone’s hometown.

Example:

I **am from/come from** the U.S. (native country)

Seth **is from/comes from** Siem Reap, Cambodia. (hometown)

To ask about someone’s native country or hometown, we use the following form:

Where + am/is/are + subject + from?

Where + does/do + subject + come from?

Example:

Where are you from? I’m from Canada.

Where does Seth come from? He comes from Cambodia.
