## **Grammar** Reference

#### Singular and Plural Nouns

Rule 1: Add "S" to a singular noun to make it plural.

<u>singular</u>	<u>plural</u>
a cat	two cat <u>s</u>
a book	three book <u>s</u>
a dog	ten dog <u>s</u>

Rule 2: Add "es" to singular nouns ending with "ch, sh, x, o, ss".

a wat <u>ch</u>	3 watch <u>es</u>
a bru <u>sh</u>	2 brush <u>es</u>
one bo <u>x</u>	three box <u>es</u>
one cla <u>ss</u>	six class <u>es</u>
a tomato	two tomatoes

#### Rule 3: irregular nouns

a child	two child <u>ren</u>
a man	four m <u>e</u> n
a woman	three wom <u>e</u> n
a person	seven people

There is/ There are: to say that something exists or happens

#### There is + singular nouns.

Example: There is <u>a dog</u> in the house.There are + plural nouns.Example: There are <u>three cats</u> in the house.

<u>There isn't/ There aren't: to say that something doesn't exist or</u> <u>happen</u>

**Example:** There isn't any water in the cup. **Example:** There aren't any boys in the class.

#### <u>Is there/ Are there: to ask whether or not something exists or</u> <u>happens</u>

Example:	
Is there any water in the cup?	Yes, there is. / No, there isn't.
Example:	
Are there any students in the class?	Yes, there are. / No, there aren't.
