


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## Prepositions of place



Preposition "in" means inside.

Example:

I watch TV in my bedroom.

Preposition "on" means above something.

Example:

The book is on the table.

Preposition "next to" means not far away.

Example:

The girl is sitting next to the boy.

Preposition "between" means in or into the space which separates two places or things.

Example:

There is a pen between a ruler and an eraser.

Preposition "in front of" means further forward than someone or something else.

Example:

She is talking to the man in front of her.

Preposition "behind" means at the back of.

Example:

I put my phone behind the TV.

Preposition "under" or "below" means lower than something else.

Example:

There is a pair of shoes under the table.

## Telling the location of a place

To ask for the location of a place, we use the following question:

Where's the ?

Example:

Where's the hospital?

It's on Main Street.

Where's the bank?

It's next to the hospital.

To give the location of a place, we use:

1. "next to" meaning very close to each other

Example: The school **is next to** the restaurant.

2. "across from" meaning on the opposite side of

Example: The movie theater is across from the drug store.

3. "between" meaning in or into the space which separates two things

Example: The library **is between** the school and the hospital.

4. "on" meaning along a street

Example: The gas station **is on** Street 184.
