Grammar Reference

Three possible ways to describe people's appearance:

1. Using adjectives: Subject + to be + adjective

Example: -She is **pretty**.

-They are **old**.

 Using adjectives + nouns: subject + have/has + adjective + noun

Example: -He has **straight hair**.

-They have blue eyes.

3. Talking about clothes: subject + to be + wearing + (adjective) clothes

Example: -I am wearing a white T-shirt.

-She is wearing a black shirt and blue jeans.

"Look like"

A question with "look like" is used to ask about somebody's appearance. Example:

What does David look like?

He's tall. He has dark hair, and he's wearing a white T-shirt.

Form:

What + does/do + subject + look like?

Note:

Who does David look like? (Ask about his similarity with another person)

He looks like his grandfather Ben.
