Grammar Reference

Comparison “as...as”

“As adjective/adverb as” is used to say that something or someone is like something or someone else.

Example:

Today is **as hot as** yesterday.

John is **as funny as** his brother.

Form:

...as + adjective/adverb + as...

“Not as adjective/adverb as” is used to say that something or someone is not like something or someone else.

Example:

Today **isn’t as hot as** yesterday.

John **isn’t as funny as** his brother.

Form:

...not as + adjective/adverb + as...

Note: We can use “not so adjective/adverb as” instead of “not as adjective/adverb as”.

Example:

It **isn’t so cold as** yesterday. (= it **isn’t as cold as**...)
